27 Dr. Crawford Williamson Long used anesthesia for childbirth for the first time, when he delivered his own child. 1845, *Carrie Nation* staged her first raid on a saloon at the Carey Hotel in Wichita. 1900, *James* Barrie's play "Peter Pan" premiered in London. 1904, Radio City Music Hall opens. 1932, Al Jolson and actress Ruby Keeler were divorced after 12 years of marriage. 1940

The Pennsylvania Gazette, owned by **Benjamin** Franklin, ran an ad for the first issue of "Poor Richard's Almanack." 1732, William F. Semple patented chewing gum. 1869, The first World Series of pro football was played. New York and Syracuse played in the indoor football game before 3,000. Syracuse, with Glen (Pop) Warner at guard, won 6-0 and went on to win the tournament. 1902, R.O. Sullivan crossed the Atlantic Ocean for the 100th time. 1942

29 The *British burned Buffalo*, NY, during the War of 1812. *President James Polk* turned on the first gas light at the White House. 1848, The first regular-season, college basketball game was played at Madison Square Garden. last weekly issue of **LIFE** magazine hit the newsstands. It later became a monthly publication. 1972



Crispy, sweet and salty, this three-ingredient snack is the ultimate cocktail party hors doeuvre.

ALL YA NEED

- •1/2 cup packed light brown sugar
- •1 1/2 tsp chile powder
- •20 slices of thick-cut bacon (1 1/2 pounds)

HOW TO

Preheat the oven to 400°.
Line 2 rimmed baking sheets with foil. In a small bowl, whisk the brown sugar with the chile powder.

Arrange the bacon strips on the foil and coat the tops with the chile sugar. Bake for 20 to 25 minutes, until caramelized and almost crisp. Transfer the bacon to a rack set over a sheet of foil to cool completely; serve.

HOW TO SOFTEN BROWN SUGAR Place hard brown sugar in a bowl and top with a dampened paper towel. Microwave for 20 to 25 seconds a pop. Don't get overzealous with the time, as the brown sugar will eventually melt into a goo, but this method works fast sted in the Cobblek litchen






