30 Edwin Hubble announced the existence of other galactic systems. 1924, California's **first freeway** was officially opened. 1940, The **first color TV** sets went on sale for about \$1,175. 1953, **The Wonderful World of Disney** was cancelled by NBC after more than 25 years on the TV. 1980

31 The **window tax** was imposed in Britain, which resulted in many windows being bricked up. 1695, **Guy Lombardo** and his Royal Canadians played **Auld Lang Syne** as a New Year's Eve song for the first time. 1929, **Roy Rogers** and **Dale Evans** were married. 1947, The world's oldest person, **Sarah Knauus** (Sept.24, 1880) died at the age of 119 years. 1999

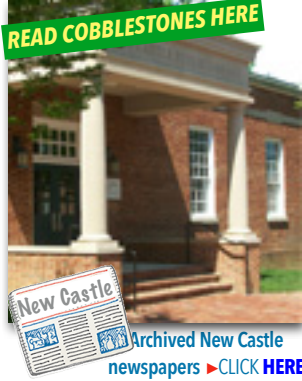

Grants are evaluated by the Outreach Committee, and voted on by the whole Board of Trustees.

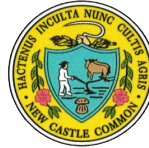

Prosciutto-Wrapped Pork Tenderloin, Peach Chutney with Asparagus

Pork Tenderloin

Kosher salt - One 1-pound pork tenderloin - 4 thin slices prosciutto - Olive oil

Peach Chutney

Two ¼ inch-thick slices pancetta, diced - ½ shallot, minced - Kosher salt - ¼ c. bourbon
2 tbsp brown sugar - 2 tbsp rice wine vinegar - 1 tbsp whole-grain mustard 2 peaches,
peeled, pitted and cut into 1/2-inch dice - 1 stick cinnamon - Thyme bundle

Asparagus

Olive oil, if needed - 1 bunch asparagus, stems removed

Directions

Gonna need toothpicks

For the pork Make oven happy at 400°. Sprinkle salt on the pork, then wrap the pork in the prosciutto and secure with toothpicks. Coat a large saute pan with oil and heat over high heat. Sear the pork on all sides, then transfer to a quarter sheet tray and roast for 8 to 10 minutes, turning the pork halfway through cooking. Reserve the saute pan with the drippings for a later use.

For the chutney Heat a large, straight-sided saute pan over medium heat. Add the pancetta and cook to render the fat. Add in the shallots and season with salt, and cook until soft and aromatic, 6 minutes. Add in the bourbon, brown sugar, vinegar, mustard, peaches, cinnamon, thyme bundle and some salt, and stir to combine. Bring to a boil and then reduce to a simmer. Simmer, stirring the peaches frequently until the liquid evaporates and the peaches are a chutney-like consistency, 10 minutes. Check to make sure the peaches are cooked through. Remove and discard the thyme bundle and cinnamon stick. Blend with an immersion blender if needed to achieve the correct consistency.

For the asparagus Return the reserved saute pan to the stove, add some oil if needed. Add the asparagus to the pan and saute until tender. Slice the tenderloin on the bias and serve with the peach chutney and asparagus.

Ruby-red cranberries make an ideal seasonal ingredient star for holiday cocktails

on the bar

2 cups frozen cranberries, plus 1/2 cup for garnish

- 1/4 cup sugar • 2 tbsp orange juice • 1 tsp orange zest
- 1 bottle Champagne

let's make some

Add cranberries, orange juice, zest and sugar to a large pan and set over medium heat until berries break-down slightly and liquid is syrupy, 12 to 15 minutes. *Pour into a blender and process, be careful of the hot liquid expanding when you blend - use a towel over the top of the blender.

Strain and discard any solids then set aside and cool. Pour 2 tbsp of cranberry-orange syrup into the bottoms of 4 chilled champagne glasses. Add a few cranberries to each glass and gently top off each glass with Champagne.



*When blending hot liquids: Remove liquid from the heat and allow to cool for at least 5 minutes. Transfer liquid to a blender or food processor and fill it no more than halfway. If using a blender, release one corner of the lid. This prevents the vacuum effect that creates heat explosions. Place a towel over the top of the machine, pulse a few times then process on high speed until smooth.

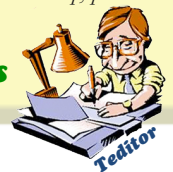
