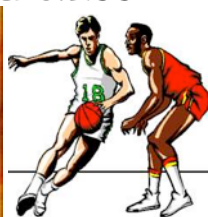

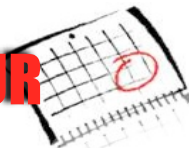

## Steal This Recipe®



### Ski Country Shepherd's Pie Dark Beer Lamb Stew & Colorado Ranch Potatoes



6 1/2 cups chicken stock  
21/2 tbsps fresh rosemary, chopped  
1/8 cup fresh thyme, chopped  
Salt and pepper to taste  
1 1/2 tbsps granulated sugar

#### Potatoes ingredients:

3 Yukon gold potatoes, rinsed, drained, shredded  
4 ozs sharp cheddar cheese, shredded  
21/2 ozs cream of chicken soup  
2 ozs crème fraiche  
Salt and pepper to taste  
Corn flakes as needed  
21/2 ozs butter

#### Potatoes instructions:

In bowl mix the potatoes with the cheese, soup, crème fraiche, salt and pepper.  
Spread into a 2" hotel half pan or casserole dish.  
Cover with layer of corn flakes and dot with butter.  
Bake 35 to 45 minutes at 325°F.  
Cool or reserve warm if using immediately.

Heat stew to desired temperature, place in oven-proof bowl.  
Cut portion of potatoes to cover dish and place over stew.  
Put back in oven or place under broiler to warm. Serve when ready.

#### Stew ingredients:

2 lbs American Lamb, 1/2-inch dice  
1 tbsps vegetable oil or olive oil  
11/2 large carrots, diced  
1/4 large bunch celery, chopped  
1 lbs pearl onions, whole  
3 cups dark beer  
1/2 cup tomato paste  
5 cups lamb stock

#### Stew instructions:

In large pan, heat the oil over medium-high heat.  
Add the lamb and brown, stirring occasionally. Remove lamb and drain.  
Add the carrots, celery and onions to the pan; sauté until onions are translucent.  
Deglaze the pan with the dark beer. Stir in the tomato paste, bring to a slow boil.  
Add the lamb stock, chicken stock, rosemary, thyme, salt, pepper and sugar.  
Reduce the heat and simmer, reducing liquid by one-third.

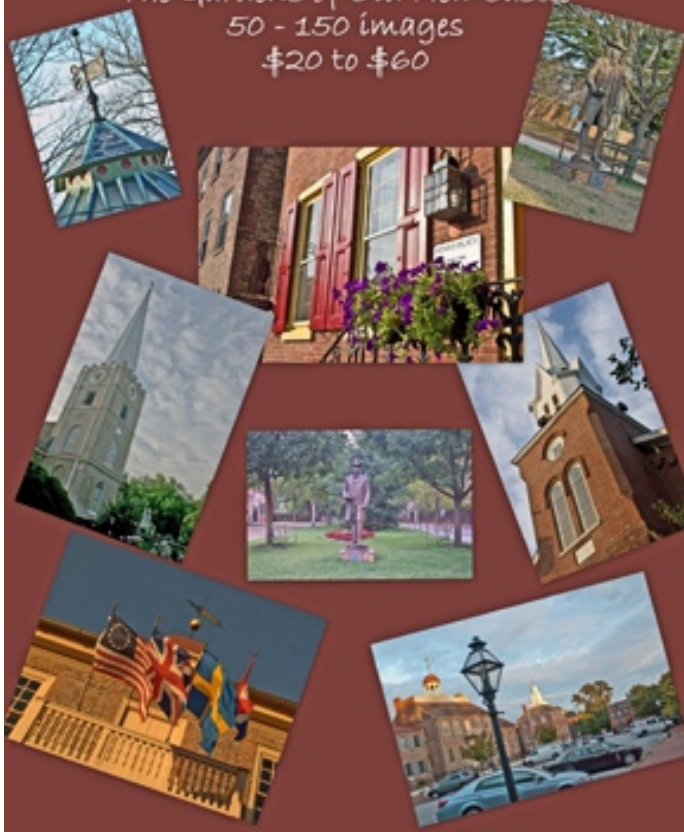
