Negotiations with Potential Tenant Continuing

Arsenal Gets a Facelift

The Arsenal on the Green, once a popular restaurant, has been vacant for over a year. Now, thanks to efforts by the Division of Historical and Cultural Affairs (DHCA), this important community landmark is getting much needed renovations aimed at preserving the historic building's charm and character and assuring that she will remain a community asset for many years to come.



Starting last fall, DHCA began renovations that have included removing old carpet, installing new flooring where needed, pouring a concrete floor in the basement, installing a new HVAC system, painting the exterior (with the exception of the shutters), as well as demolition and clean up of interior components. Renovations are anticipated to be completed by fall.

Originally built for ordinance supply storage between 1809 and 1811, the Arsenal on the Green has gone through many changes in her 200 years. She has been in turn a storage site for arms and munitions; suitable accommodations for companies of Delaware troops; a hospital during the 1832 cholera epidemic; a school; a post office; a printing office for the New Castle Gazette, and a storehouse for tools for repair of New Castle harbor as well as an office for Bellanca Aircraft before becoming a venue for the historic restaurant "The Arsenal on the Green" in 1963.

Today, the Arsenal is a State owned property overseen by DHCA. DHCA utilized the Historic New Castle Alliance (HNCA) to assist in finding a potential partner for the use of this community cornerstone. Through the work of a subcommittee, a process was developed in which proposals were reviewed and a potential tenant was selected. DHCA is currently negotiating with the potential tenant and his designer.

HNCA is looking forward to the results of the negotiations between the state and potential tenant so that this wonderful venue can once again be enjoyed by all.

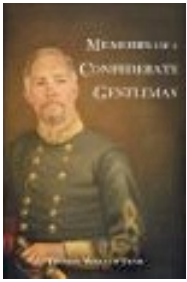

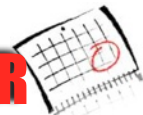

Chicken Wings with Red Hot Honey Glaze and Blue Cheese Celery Dipping Sauce



For the wings: *you'll need*

- 1 c. hot sauce
- 1/2 c. honey
- 6 tbsps unsalted butter
- 1 tbsp red wine vinegar
- Salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 24 chicken wings, tips removed

For the sauce:

- 1/2 c. mayonnaise
- 1/2 c. Greek yogurt
- 1 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1/4 c. finely diced celery
- 1/2 c. crumbled blue cheese*
(recommended: Cabrales)
- 2 tbsps finely chopped fresh chives
- Salt
- Freshly ground black pepper

For the wings:

Heat grill to medium-high. Combine the hot sauce, honey and butter in a small [saucepan](#) and cook over medium heat until the butter is melted and the mixture comes together, about 5 minutes. Stir in the vinegar and season with salt and pepper. Pour half of the sauce in a bowl and keep the remaining sauce in the pan, warm over low heat. Season the wings on both sides with the salt and pepper. Brush the wings with the reserved sauce in the bowl and place on the grill. Grill on each side for 5 minutes or until golden brown and cooked through. Remove wings from the grill and toss with the warm hot sauce. Transfer to a platter and serve with the [blue cheese](#) sauce on the side for dipping.

For the blue cheese-celery dipping sauce:

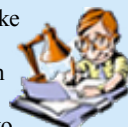
Cobblestones is growing!
