Memorial Day occurs on the last Monday of May each year in honor of U.S. military personnel who have died during military service. The day, originally Decoration Day, first took place in Charleston after the Civil War in 1865 when freed slaves created a cemetery as a way to remember fallen Union soldiers. It wasn't until after World War I that the federal holiday honored all fallen military personnel for any war. The name Memorial Day began being used in 1882, however the holiday name wasn't officially changed until 1967. Because of its origination, many states in the South at first rejected Decoration Day and wouldn't recognize it. However, slowly the holiday was accepted by every state and remains so today. It is tradition to mark the holiday by flying the national flag at half mast and numerous memorial ceremonies held throughout the U.S.

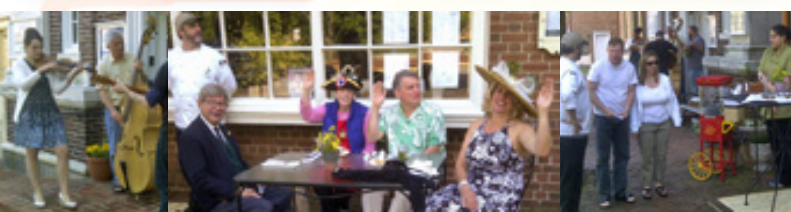

Escape From Fort Delaware Triathlon

Last Sunday, May 22nd over 200 athletes from the eastern sea board converged on Delaware City to compete in

the annual "Escape From Fort Delaware" triathlon.

The race that started on Pea Patch Island consisted of a 1 mile swim to Delaware City, a 25 mile bike, and concluded with a 6.2 mile run.

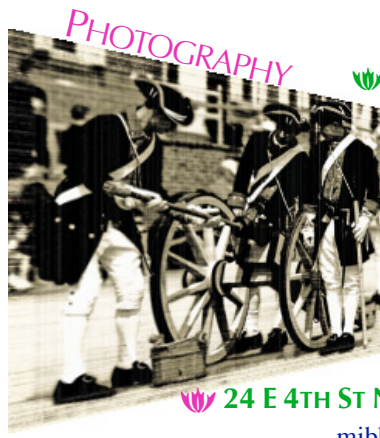
The winning time of 2:08:20 went to **Greg Reznich** of Philadelphia.

The first female to cross the finish line and 11th place overall went to **Audrey Jaccobs** of New York.

The first Delaware athlete and 8th place overall went to **Kent Buckson** of Rehoboth Beach, in a time of 2:18:24.

By finishing first from Delaware, Buckson qualified for National triathlon competition to be held later on during the summer months in the mid west.

Ed Note - I was told only 14 swimmers need assistance during the event. A very good number I'm told. Other events have has 30 plus rescues.

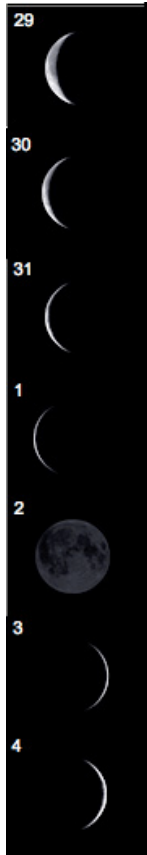
