






Monday of May each year in honor of U.S. military personnel who have died during military service. The day, originally

Decoration Day, first took place in Charleston after the Civil War in 1865 when freed slaves created a cemetery as a way to remember fallen Union soldiers.

It wasn't until after World War I that the federal holiday honored all fallen military personnel for any war. The name Memorial Day began being used in 1882, however the holiday name wasn't officially changed until 1967. Because of its origination, many states in the South at first rejected Decoration Day and wouldn't recognize it. However, slowly the holiday was accepted by every state and remains so today. It is tradition to mark the holiday by flying the national flag at half mast and numerous memorial ceremonies held throughout the U.S.

The race that started on Pea Patch Island consisted of a 1 mile swim to Delaware City, a 25 mile bike, and concluded with a 6.2 mile run.


The winning time of 2:08:20 went to **Greg Reznich** of Philadelphia.


