On Thursday, June 14, the Delaware Senate unanimously passed HB 307, approving Charter changes for the City of New Castle. The Delaware House of Representatives had previously approved HB 307, also in a unanimous vote.

The final step in the General Assembly legislative process is for Governor Markell to sign this bill.

If you're thirsty before hitting the gym? What to drink before a workout has long been up for debate. Everyone has their pre-exercise ritual.

Worst Drink: Minute Maid Lemonade The store-bought varieties of this classic beverage are made with the same sweeteners as soda and contain just as much sugar.

Worst Drink: Rockstar Energy Drink: There are rows upon rows of energy drinks at the grocery store these days. They all claim to provide the energy you need to power through anything, whether it's an intense workout or a long day at the office. But what isn't mentioned is the high amount of calories and sugar found in these drinks. Rockstar is one of the worst, with one 16-ounce can coming in at 280 calories and 62 grams of sugar.
