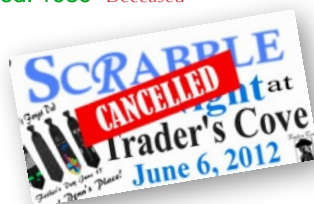

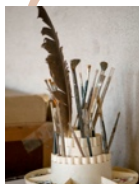

D-DAY 68 years ago a triumph of intelligence, coordination, secrecy, and planning.

D-Day was originally scheduled for June 5, but the weather did not cooperate. The operation was pushed back to **June 6, 1944**.
 The D-Day invasion involved 5,000 ships carrying men and vehicles across the English Channel as well as 800 planes dropping over 13,000

Many scholars have tried to explain the term "**D-Day**," suggesting it stood for "decision day" or "disembarkation day," but most likely it comes from the army's use of the term to mean an "undefined day," or the first day of any operation.

men in parachutes. A further 300 planes dropped bombs on German troops defending the beaches. Over 100,000 Allied troops made it to shore that day.
 The most difficult landing of D-Day was at Omaha beach. Navigation problems resulted in many men drowning before they reached land. Omaha Beach also had the largest amount of German troops, and the fighting was fierce. It is the Omaha Beach battle that is reenacted in the opening of the movie *Saving Private Ryan*.
 The success of D-Day was a death knell for the Germans. Hitler was forced to fight a two-front war against the Russians on the East and the Americans, British, Canadians, and French on the West. Within a year, Hitler committed suicide, and the war was over.

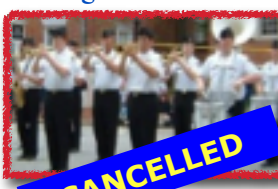

Chocolate Silk Pie

Stuff...

4 large eggs
3/4 c. sugar
2 tbsps water or coffee
10 tbsps (1 1/4 sticks) unsalted butter, softened
1/4 tsp kosher salt
3 ounces bittersweet or semisweet chocolate, or a mix

of both, melted and cooled slightly
1 1/2 tps vanilla extract
1 baked 9-inch pie crust
1 c. heavy cream
1 tbsp confectioners' sugar
Chocolate shavings, for garnish

Do it...

1. Fill a medium pot with 1 inch water over medium heat. Whisk the eggs with 1/2 c. of the sugar and the water or coffee in a large heatproof bowl that will fit over the pot without touching the water. Place the bowl over the simmering water and continue whisking constantly until the eggs become thick and fluffy, and a drizzle of the mixture will hold its shape and sit on top of the custard, about 5 minutes. Remove from the heat and set aside to cool, whisking occasionally so the eggs do not scramble.



2. Combine the butter, salt and remaining 1/4 c. sugar in a large bowl and beat in a stand mixer or with hand beaters on medium-high speed until fluffy. Pour in the chocolate and 1 1/4 tps of the vanilla and continue to beat, scraping down the sides of the bowl as needed, until combined. Add the custard and continue to beat until the filling is thick, fluffy and smooth, about 5 minutes.

3. Spread into the pie crust and cover with plastic wrap. Chill until cold and set, 2 to 3 hours. Before serving, whip the cream with the confectioners' sugar and remaining 1/4 tsp vanilla until it forms soft peaks. Spread over the pie filling and garnish with chocolate shavings.

Cobbles know... to substitute your favorite liqueur in place of the water or coffee. Kahlua, Chambord or Grand Marnier are all great choices.

Use a large bowl for cooking the custard. It will keep your hand further from the heat, and your eggs will cook faster
