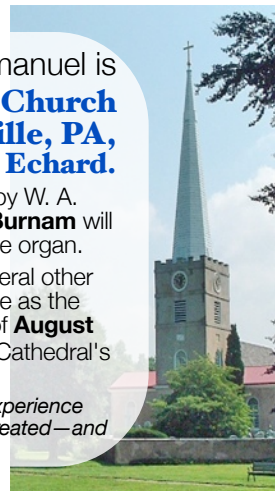
"Pop-up" art is an outdoor museum exhibition that uses main streets and landmark outdoor spaces as its gallery space. Realistic reproductions of works of art are printed to scale, framed, and then installed in pedestrian-friendly outdoor locations—including parks, the sides of public or private buildings, and other locations where people gather. The purpose of a pop-up art exhibition is to interact with audiences outside traditional museum walls.

In celebration of the Delaware Art Museum's 100th anniversary, and in conjunction with **100 Works for 100 Years**—a Museum-wide installation featuring one or more works from each year of the Museum's existence—the Delaware Art Museum is thrilled to present its very first pop-up art exhibition! The exhibition, titled **Art is Everywhere**, will be on view statewide through early October, 2012. Gorgeous reproductions of some of the Museum's most treasured paintings, such as Howard Pyle's *The Mermaid*, Winslow Homer's *Milking Time*, and Edward Hopper's *Summertime*, will be on view.

# porterhouse *with* balsamic steak sauce

## directions

Preheat a grill to high on one side and lightly oil the grate. Season a 2-inch-thick

**porterhouse steak** (3 lbs) with **coarse sea salt & pepper**. Grill over direct heat for 4 minutes, then rotate the meat 90 and cook 2 more minutes. Repeat on the other side. Move the steak to the cooler part of the grill (position the smaller end away from the heat); cover and cook until the meat reaches 128 to 130 for medium-rare, 12 to 15 minutes. Let rest 5 minutes before slicing.



**sauce** To make the sauce, simmer 3/4 cup **balsamic vinegar**, 2/3 cup **ketchup**, 1/4 cup **honey**, 2 sliced **shallots**, 2 tbsp **Worcestershire sauce**, 1 tbsp **dijon mustard**, 1/4 tsp **allspice**, **salt**, **pepper** and **sugar** to taste until thickened, about 15 minutes. Strain, then whisk in some **butter**.

# Tequila sangria

## ingredients

- 2 to 3 pineapple slices
- 2 to 3 orange slices
- 2 to 3 [blackberries](#)
- 2 to 3 lime wedges
- 2 ounce or 1/4 cup [tequila](#)
- 1 ounce or 2 tbsp elderflower-flavored liqueur\*



- 1 ounce or 2 tbsp [simple syrup](#)\*
- 2 ounces or 1/4 cup pineapple juice
- Splash orange juice
- Ice, as needed
- Red [wine](#), as needed (recommended: rioja)
- \*Cook's Note: peach-, pear- or ginger-flavored liqueur can be substituted.
- \*Cook's Note: Simple syrup is equal parts [sugar](#) and water

cooked until the sugar dissolves and then cooled completely.

## directions

In desired drinking glass, add the [pineapples](#), [oranges](#), blackberries, and [lime](#) wedges. Cook's Note: If you don't like the fruits suggested here feel free to use whichever fruits you desire.

Next add the tequila, elderflower-flavored [liqueur](#), simple syrup, pineapple juice, and [orange juice](#). Add ice to glass and stir to mix ingredients. Top glass with red wine and enjoy!

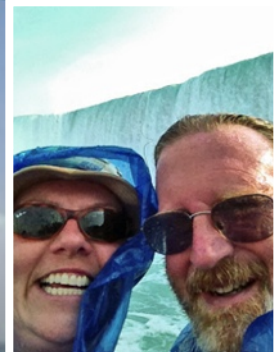
The film will be introduced by the filmmaker, Michael Oates, who will be available for questions afterward.

At your next BBQ don't spend money on anti-pest candles that never work. Simmer 2 cups of milk, 1/4 pound of sugar, and 2 oz. of ground black pepper for 10 minutes, stirring occasionally. Pour the mixture into bowls and put them where the flies will be attracted to them and then drown. You can also place around the house, No more buzzing at the windows.
