porterhouse with balsamic steak sauce

Preheat a grill to high on one side and lightly rections oil the grate. Season a 2-inch-thick

porterhouse steak (3 lbs) with coarse sea salt & pepper. Grill over direct heat for 4 minutes, then rotate the meat 90 and cook 2 more minutes. Repeat on the other side. Move the steak to the cooler part of the grill (position the smaller end away from the heat); cover and cook until the meat reaches 128 to 130 for medium-rare, 12 to 15 minutes. Let rest 5 minutes before slicing.



To make the sauce, simmer 3/4 cup balsamic vinegar, 2/3 cup ketchup, 1/4 cup honey, 2 sliced shallots, 2 tbsp Worcestershire sauce, 1 tbsp dijon mustard, 1/4 tsp allspice, salt, pepper and

sugar to taste until thickened, about 15 minutes. Strain, then whisk in some butter.

In desired drinking glass, add the pineapples, oranges, blackberries, and lime wedges. Cook's Note: If you don't like the fruits suggested here feel free to use whichever fruits you desire.

Next add the teguila, elderflower-flavored liqueur, simple syrup, pineapple juice, and orange juice. Add ice to glass and stir to mix ingredients. Top glass with red wine and enjoy!


