44 Classic T-Birds coming to town Thursday!

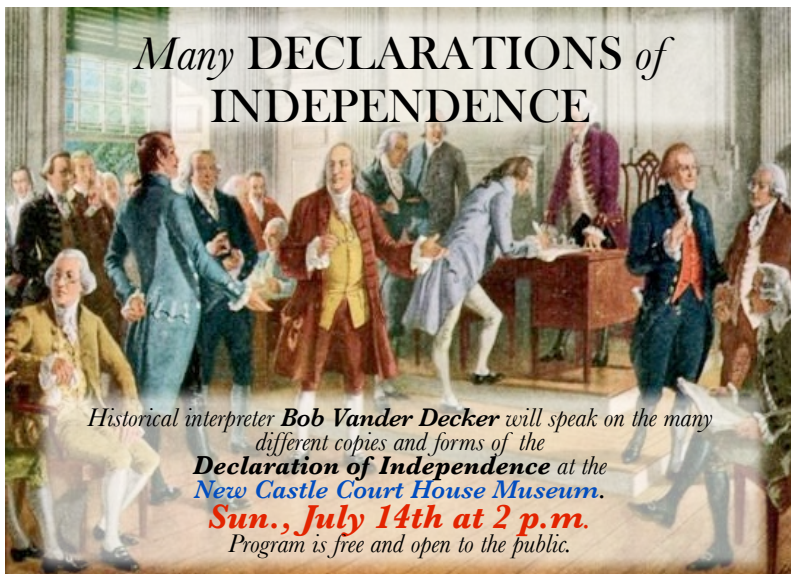

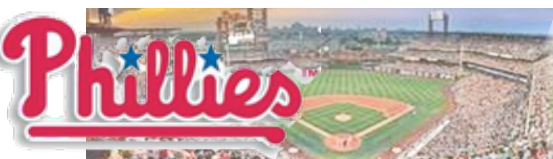

goes in the guacamole

- 2 ripe avocados, peeled, pitted and coarsely chopped
- 1 large jalapeño, finely diced
- 3 tbsps finely diced red onion
- 1 lime, juiced
- 2 tbsps canola oil
- 3 tbsps chopped fresh cilantro leaves
- Salt
- Freshly ground black pepper

goes in the grilled salsa

- 4 plum tomatoes
- 4 tbsps canola oil
- Salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 3 tbsps red wine vinegar
- 2 tps chipotle in adobo puree
- 3 tbsps finely diced red onion

do you really need to know about

- 8 kosher beef or turkey or chicken hot dogs
- 8 hot dog buns, split 3/4 of the way through
- 1 1/2 cups grated white Cheddar
- 8 pickled jalapeños, thinly sliced

here's ho to...

For the guacamole: Combine the avocados, jalapeño, onion, lime juice, oil and cilantro in a bowl and gently mix until combined. Season with salt and pepper.

For the Grilled Tomato-Chipotle Salsa: Heat the grill to high. Brush tomatoes with 2 tbsps of the canola oil and season with salt and pepper. Place on the grill and grill until charred on all sides. Remove from the grill, slice the tomatoes in half, remove the seeds and coarsely chop.

Whisk together the remaining 2 tbsps of oil, vinegar, chipotle puree and onion in a small bowl, add the tomatoes and stir to combine. Season with salt and pepper.

For the hot dogs:

Preheat the grill to high. Grill hot dogs until golden brown on all sides, about 7 minutes. Remove to a plate. Place buns on the grill cut side down and grill until lightly golden brown, about 20 seconds. Place hot dogs in the buns, top with cheese, jalapeño, guacamole, salsa and tortilla chips.

Summer Fruit Slaw

Makes 4 cups

you'll need:



- 1 apple, washed with stems and bottom removed
- 1 crisp pear, washed with stems and bottom removed
- 1 large stalk rhubarb, washed with top and bottom removed
- 1/2 red onion, thinly sliced
- 1/2 cup orange juice
- 1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 teaspoon honey

now make it:

Slice the apples into quarters, cutting around the core and seeds. Then cut those pieces until you have a bunch of thin, apple matchsticks. Repeat with the pears. And finally, cut the rhubarb into quarters, so that each piece is approximately the same length as your apple and pear matchsticks, and cut those pieces into thin matchsticks as well.

Then place the apples and rhubarb into a large bowl and place your pears aside in a separate, smaller bowl. Add the red onion, orange juice, apple cider vinegar, and honey to the apple, rhubarb bowl and give it a good mix (with a wooden spoon or your hands) until everything is combined. Cover both bowls with foil and place them into the refrigerator to cool and marinate, 30 minutes to 1 hour. Before serving, add your pears to the apple, rhubarb bowl, give it a good swirl.
