Rare aircraft on tour arrive at New Castle Airport

The National Wings of Freedom tour hits New Castle Airport **Aug. 27 - 29** with a **WWII Vintage Boeing B-17 Flying Fortress, Consolidated B-24 Liberator and North American P-51 Mustang.**

The B-17 is one of only 10 in flying condition in the United States and the B-24J and Full Dual Control P-51C Mustang are the sole remaining examples of their type flying in the World.

Admission to explore the aircraft inside and out is \$12, \$6 for children younger than 12. WWII Veterans can tour for free. A 30-minute flight aboard the B-17 or B-24 is \$425 . P-51 flights are \$2,200 for a half hour. (Call [800] 568-8924).

The planes will be open from 2 pm to 5 pm Aug. 27, 9 am to 5 pm Aug. 28 and 9 am until noon Aug. 29. www.collingsfoundation.org.

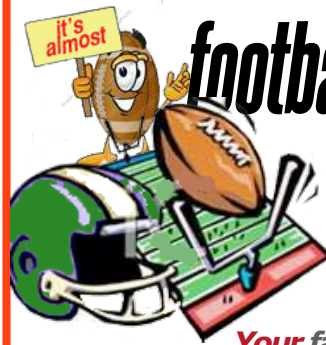

Linguine Mare Chiaro

Ingredients

- 1/2 C. plus 1/3 c. olive oil
- 4 Garlic cloves, smashed
- 18 Small, fresh clams, well rinsed
- 18 Mussels, well rinsed and de-bearded
- 3 C.s canned whole tomatoes, cut lengthwise into strips
- 6 Fresh medium basil leaves, torn into small pieces
- 18 Large shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 18 Large scallops
- 1/4 C. chopped fresh Italian parsley
- 6 Tsp sea salt
- 1/4 Tsp freshly ground pepper
- 1 C. dry white wine
- 1 Pound dry linguine
- 2 Tbsps extra virgin olive oil

instructions

Heat 1/4 c. of the olive oil in a large sauté pan over medium-high heat. Add 3 of the garlic cloves and cook 2-3 minutes. Add the clams and mussels in their shells. Cover and cook until the shells open, 2-3 minutes. Transfer to a bowl. Strain the cooking liquid and reserve in a separate bowl. Wipe out the pan and return to the stove. Add 1/3 c. of the olive oil and heat over high heat. Add the remaining garlic clove. Cook 1 minute. Add the tomatoes and basil and cook 3-5 minutes. Add the reserved liquid from the clams and mussels. Bring the mixture to a boil. Reduce the heat and simmer for 25 minutes. Meanwhile, heat the remaining 1/4 c. of olive oil in a large sauté pan over medium-high heat. Add the shrimp, scallops, half of the parsley, 1 tsp of the salt and the pepper. Cook 1-2 minutes. Add the wine and cook 1 minute. Remove the shrimp and scallops. Cook the remaining liquid until the wine is reduced by half; about 2 minutes. Bring 5 quarts of water and the remaining 5 tps of salt to a boil in a large stockpot over high heat. Add the pasta and cook until tender. Transfer to a colander to drain. Add the clams, mussels, shrimp and scallops to the tomato sauce, reserving about 6 of each for a garnish. Add the pasta to the tomato sauce and toss to coat well. Transfer to a platter and arrange the reserved seafood around the edges of the pasta. Drizzle with the extra-virgin olive oil and sprinkle with the remaining parsley.

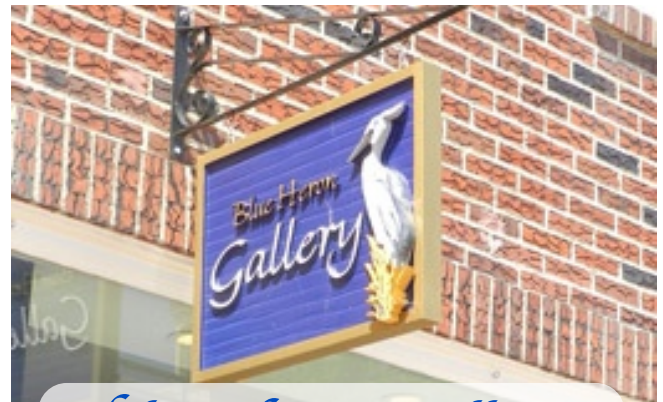

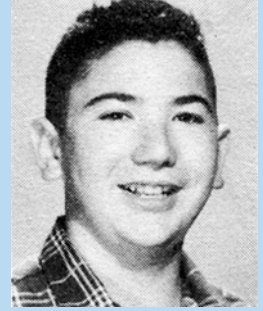
