DIKE ASSESSMENT AND REHABILITATION

September 9, 2012

City, County and State officials and public and private professionals continue to review information on the condition of the dikes and work towards development of a process for rehabilitation of these critical structures.

Related discussions will take place at the regular **City Council meeting at 7 p.m. on September 11 at the Town Hall.**



The General Assembly approved \$3 million in the 2011-12

State budget earmarked for dikes. An additional \$2.5 million was approved and included in the 2012-13 budget for dikes/dams.

The highest priority repair is the Red Lion dike, followed by the three dikes within the City: Buttonwood, Broad Marsh and Gambacorta Marsh, and finally a fifth dike: Army Creek.





inaredients

- 2 racks baby back ribs about 4 to 6 ribs per person
- Grev salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- Espresso or your own Sauce

1 handful fresh mint leaves plus more for garnish 11/2 ounces aged rum 1/2 ounce freshly-squeezed lime juice 1 to 11/2 teaspoons superfine sugar or 1/2 ounce Simple Syrup, recipe follows 2 dashes bitters, (recommended: Angostura) Ice cubes

11/2 to 2 ounces dry Champagne, Prosecco or other sparkling wine

Muddle the mint leaves with the rum, lime juice, Simple Syrup, and bitters in a cocktail shaker. Add ice, cover, and shake vigorously, or stir, until combined and chilled, about 30 seconds. (In general, the drink is readv when the shaker mists up.) Pour the muddled liquid into a chilled champagne flute, holding back the ice, but letting some of the mint leaves fall into the glass. Add enough Champagne to almost fill the glass to the top. Garnish with a sprig of mint. Drink.
