

DelDOT proposal

SR (State Rt.) 9 provides traffic relief for overflowing traffic from US 13/US 40 and functions as a through-traffic state highway. In 2008, the **City of New Castle** prompted DelDOT to complete a traffic study of the corridor and develop a comprehensive plan to reduce cut-through traffic. The study was completed in 2009 that evaluated the functional and operational characteristics of traffic around the **City of New Castle**. The study found that cut-through traffic routes result in increased traffic on 3rd St., 6th St., and 7th St., and produces long queues and deficiencies at the intersections.


